- Preference will be given to those who applicant and/or parent (guardian) are a voting member (Class A) in good standing of Landus, account number required.
- Dependents of directors and officers of Landus are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- The application must be postmarked or submitted via email no later than <u>Friday, March 29, 2024</u> in order to be considered for the award.
